Good afternoon!

You are invited to submit a sculpture to be displayed in a city-owned park in Lampasas, Texas. A board panel will choose five artists to exhibit their work in city-owned Campbell Park, also known as Hanna Springs Sculpture Garden. Following installation, there will be an artist dinner, and overnight accommodations will be provided. This is a beautiful opportunity for sculptors of large outdoor works to exhibit in a park environment in a small, friendly town at a busy Central Texas crossroads between Austin and Dallas/Ft Worth.

Each sculptor will receive a stipend of **\$1,000.00** on completion of installation on **September 14, 2024**. **The work must remain in the park for one year.**

The park's proximity to historic downtown Lampasas makes it possible for many residents, school children, and out-of-town visitors to visit the sculpture garden and experience art.
